Item #1 Administrative Reports

Monthly Public Works Monthly Activities Report - Mayor Glenn McFadden recognized Public Works Director, Ashley Wimberly. Mr. Wimberly presented the March and May 2020 monthly report. He reviewed all projects with the Town Board. The monthly report was provided to Town Board members for informational purposes.

Item #2 Discussion of Regular Meeting Agenda for June 9, 2020.

Town Manager, Mr. Joseph Jeffries, reviewed the Agenda for the June 9, 2020, Regular Meeting.

Joseph Jeffries, Town Manager, discussed with the Board the July 4th Fireworks, because the Town has already entered an agreement with Dan Denning for the Fireworks presentation. An option was mentioned to do a fireworks display Labor Day weekend.

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The Board of Commissioners came to the consensus to allow the Special Events Committee to meet and come up with an alternative date for a fireworks presentation.

Mayor McFadden stated that currently Lillington has not experienced any riots like surrounding areas. He explained that if this became an issue here in Town he would be placing curfews on the residents. Mayor McFadden polled the Board of Commissioners and there were no objections.

Mayor McFadden then polled each Board Member and asked if there were any questions regarding the Proposed 2020-2021 Annual Budget. There were no questions from the Board.


Commissioner Stephens became present at 8:50 a.m.

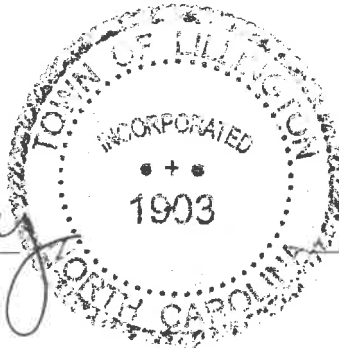
There was no other discussion on this item.


Adjournment: Commissioner Langdon moved that the meeting be adjourned. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Page and unanimously approved.
