**Call to Order & Welcome:** Mayor Glenn McFadden called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**Item #1 Discussion and Consideration of the 2022 Gun Violence Awareness and Gun Safety Event**

Mayor Glenn McFadden recognized Alicia Gregory, Administrative Services Director. Ms. Gregory informed the Board that Ms. Tiffany Campbell wrote a letter to the Board requesting to use the River Park on July 30, 2022 to host the community event, *Guns Down, Family Up*. Commissioner Babb voiced his concerns regarding Ms. Campbell hosting this event at the Riverpark. The Board stated they would like Ms. Campbell to provide an agenda for the event and stated she would also need to complete a Special Events Application for the event. Commissioners also stated that this event would need to come before the Board annually for approval. Commissioner Page made a motion to approve Ms. Campbell's request to use the River Park to Host the community event, *Guns Down, Family Up*, contingent upon receipt of the items requested. Commissioner Langdon seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

**Item #2 Discussion and Approval of an Easement with Duke Energy Progress, LLC regarding E. Duncan Street**

Mayor Glenn McFadden recognized Alicia Gregory, Administrative Services Director. Ms. Gregory stated the easement is needed at the multipurpose field for power so they will have irrigation and lights. Duke Energy, LLC needs permission from the Board to put power at that location. Ms. Gregory stated the easement is near the parking lot near the tree line. Commissioner McPhail made a motion to approve the easement with Duke Energy Progress, LLC. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion that passed unanimously.

**Item #3 Administrative Reports**

*Monthly Public Works Activities Report* – Mayor Glenn McFadden recognized Ashley Wimberly, Public Works. Mr. Wimberly reviewed ongoing projects and completed projects.

*Monthly Financial Report* – Mayor Glenn McFadden recognized Lisa Young, Assistant Town Manager. Ms. Young reviewed the monthly summaries for the Town’s revenues, expenditures, and year-to-date fund balances in the General Fund, Water/Sewer Fund, and the Powell Bill Fund for the month of June.

*Town Manager’s Report* – Mayor Glenn McFadden recognized Joseph Jeffries, Town Manager. Mr. Jeffries updated the Board on current and ongoing projects. Mr. Jeffries also sought guidance from the Board in regards to an idea he has for the Senter Family Park. Mr. Jeffries presented the idea of the park being for everyone but gearing it more towards seniors and having a rubber walking loop trail and other handicap accessible workout equipment. The Board was pleased with the idea and it was the consensus of the Board for Mr. Jeffries to move forward with the idea.

Mayor Glenn McFadden reviewed the Agenda for the July 12, 2022, Regular Meeting.


**Item #5 Closed Session to Meet per §143-318.11(a)(5), & §143-318.11(a)(6)**

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to enter closed session. Commissioner Page seconded the motion that passed unanimously.


Commissioner McPhail made a motion to come out of closed session. Commissioner Page seconded the motion that passed unanimously.
